BALLOT ENTRY FORM

For out of zone students, the Matamata Primary School Board of Trustees determine the number of places which are to be available. The notice indicates the number of places for the class level, how applications are made and specifies a date by which all applications must be received. Applications for enrolment are processed in the ballot in order of priority. A ballot will be conducted if there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth, or fifth priority groups than there are places available.
